#### **GMAIL**


Make sure your virtual assistant has its own Google account. In case you haven't heard, Gmail is Google's email service, and it's completely free to use.

Enables you to chat in real time, make phone and video calls, hold group video conferences, and share screens.




#### **ZOOM MEETING**
